Pine Forest Children's Community Transferred to New Non-Profit

Pine Forest Children's Community was legally transferred to a new non-profit organization called Pine Forest, Inc. on August 30, 2010.

On Monday morning, Pine Forest Children's Center, formerly the Pine Forest Children's Community, opened its doors under their new name at their same location at 208 Flynn Avenue in Burlington.

According to Catherine Simonson, Director of HowardCenter Child, Youth & Family Services that has overseen the operation of Pine Forest in the past, "We would have been faced with closing the center by the end of August if a viable plan by a new organization could not be identified. We are excited to have this wonderful solution and are grateful that the South End of Burlington will continue to be served by an accredited childcare center."

Pine Forest Children's Center is fully licensed for 75 children, and enrollment is very strong. Wendy Lachapelle will continue as the Director of the center with most teachers remaining on staff.
