

Project CRASH Residential Weekend
Drinking Driver Rehabilitation Program (DDRP)

Enclosed is the enrollment paperwork that must be completed to register for the Project CRASH DDRP Residential Weekend Program. You are not guaranteed a place in the program until the Registration, Intake Questionnaire, Release of Confidential Information, Release of Medical Information for CRASH Program Participation, Physical Exam certificate, and Money Order payable to HOWARDCenter in the amount of \$600.00 is received. **Registration is on a first received basis and processed as they are received.** The weekend program fills up fast, so it is important to register as soon as possible. Meals are served at scheduled times in the cafeteria. **Fee includes room, meals and administration fee; this portion of the fee is non-refundable.**

Each participant must have a routine physical. We must have a signed statement from a doctor stating that you are medically cleared to participate in the program. Enclosed is a Physical Exam form (*your doctor may choose to use a similar form*), and Release of Information for CRASH Participation document. Both forms need to be completed. Without this documentation, you will not be allowed to participate in the program (**NO EXCEPTIONS**). The *completed* physical exam may be brought with you when you check in on Friday so your reservation is not delayed.

According to State requirements, first offenders may be required to attend further counseling in order to complete the program. This treatment program will consist of a MINIMUM of 6 hours and 4 sessions, and they must continue over a MINIMUM period of 4 weeks. SECOND OFFENDERS are mandated to attend a MINIMUM of six months and at least 20 sessions of alcohol treatment.

Arrive in Huntington Vermont at Sleepy Hollow Inn for check-in between 3:00 and 3:30^{pm} on Friday of your scheduled weekend. **Transportation is your responsibility** and you will be available to leave between 11:00^{am} and noon on Sunday.

Location details and schedule for the weekend are sent with a letter of confirmation. **Last minute cancellations** will be scheduled to the next available weekend **after re-payment** of the room, meals and administrative portion of the fee.
