

STATE OF VERMONT PROJECT CRASH EDUCATIONAL PROGRAM RULES WEEKEND RESIDENTIAL PROGRAM

OBJECTIVES OF THE CRASH EDUCATIONAL PROGRAM:

- To provide you education about alcohol use and its effects on you and the community.
- To provide you with the opportunity to examine your own drinking and driving behavior.
- To inform you of the resources available to assist you in changing your drinking behavior if you find you need or want to.

RULES AND REQUIREMENTS OF THE CRASH EDUCATION PROGRAM ARE:

- Arrive promptly between 3:00-3:30 pm on Friday afternoon for registration and intake sessions.
- Attend all sessions. An absence during a session will be considered a drop and will result in being dismissed from this course. A new registration for another CRASH Educational program is required.
- Come to session on time. Tardiness will result in being dismissed from this course. A new registration for another CRASH Educational program would be required.
- Attend program alcohol and drug free. Any evidence of the use of substances prior to, or during the program, may require you to submit a urine sample and can result in immediate dismissal from the course, and a registration for another CRASH Educational Program is required.
- Active participation in session discussion (as determined by group leaders) will be required at all sessions.
- A satisfactory plan to avoid future occurrences of driving under the influence of alcohol or drugs will be developed by the individual and presented at the final session for review by the group.
- Some individuals may be required to attend counseling before CRASH is considered complete.
- CONFIDENTIALITY IS A MUST.

FEES and REGISTRATION

- A fee of \$600.00 is due upon registering for the CRASH Educational Program. Payment by money order ONLY. Registration and fee must be received by HOWARDCenter *at least 2 weeks* prior to the beginning of the class. Registrations will be processed as they are received. Upon receipt of Registration, Intake Questionnaire, Releases and Money Order you will be registered in the next available class and a confirmation letter will be mailed to you.
- If an individual **fails to successfully complete** the CRASH Educational Program, **no monies will be refunded**. An individual may register for a second Weekend CRASH Program by notifying **HOWARDCenter (802) 488-6151**, *if there has not been an additional alcohol related offense*. **Additional room, meals and administrative charge of \$250.00 will be required for the second program.**
- Failure to satisfactorily complete a second CRASH Educational Program will require an additional registration with another full payment of \$600.00

NOTE: A physical exam is mandatory in order to attend the Weekend Residential Program. The physician completed document may be brought with you when you check-in for the weekend.
